

ASHANKURA TRUST Urban home rescued children Education Access

Ashankura will reach these kinds of locations and mobilise parents and children for formal orientation/awareness camp and ask them about their children's education and encourage them to join the school (informal education) for about two to three months at their nearby locations alone and also some TENT SCHOOL. Once if any children's are more interested and after the orientation from our team we will make them to join to govt. school for further studies and this way we will bring these children's into mainstream of formal education.

We have made Three tent school and Three Anganavadi School as a intervention of our efforts in this regard. And also via this these people can also are able to avail various Govt. Schemes like Bhagya Lakshmi Yojana.

We have made provision for Hindi as well as local language speaking education system considering the limitations of the migrant communities. And also who are staying from 25 year or more and they are willing to settle down in Bangalore alone we are encouraging them to learn Kannada/English and made school admission accordingly.

There is a category called seasonal migrant workers also we are reaching out to their children and made all the above mentioned provision along with the hostel facilities as per the need arise. There also will be school dropout once the migrant moves back to their hometown which is very minimum as per our records due to their enhanced life style in urban/metro cities.

There has been a case study about Rajasthani Migrant begging community; as per our intervention we made only adult to go for begging and their children for non-formal schooling later supported with hostel facilities as well. This reduced the Children's street begging. The entire operation and approach has been running complete free of cost (Most of the time self support and donors/well wisher etc.)

BRIDGE education support system (Numeracy and Literacy) also will be a part of our entire process. Later we will encourage to NIOS open schooling also for their higher education as per their trade and interested skills. These are all with post follow-up and monitoring visits from Ashankura will be taking place on a regular time interval to ensure the growth of the child's education system.
